Christine Paternostro, President, After Prom Steering Committee called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm

President's report—Ms. Paternostro welcomed all in attendance (77).

The After Prom will be April 24, 2020 from 11:30 pm-5:30am. It will be at Steinert High School. There are sign up sheets for all committees to sign up.

Christine explained that the most important reason to hold the After Prom is to keep our students and their dates safe, with that being said, she reminded everyone that the Fashion Show is a fundraiser for the after prom, not the main event. There is a change in how the models will be chosen this year. The school is taking that part over and those wishing to be considered to be a model must fill out an application and return it to Mr. Wheeler. There is also options this year for the students to MC the event, help with decorations, community service, and publicity.

Treasurer's report— Ms. Haley explained to all the chairs the process of spending and receiving money, and what forms to fill out. Tax and shipping cannot be reimbursed. The budget for this year is approximately \$34,000.00. It includes the actual event, plus senior breakfast, senior gifts, organization costs, permits and scholarships. It is always a work in progress, the more money raised, the more we can do at the actual event.

We made \$110.00 on the Spoony Sweet Fundraiser.

Vice President's report—Ms. Kieffer welcomed everyone in attendance. Reminded everyone to sign up for a comiteee.

Secretary's report—Ms. Gaskill asked everyone to sign the attendance sheet. The secretary will forward information from Chairs that needs to be distributed to the other chairpersons, and it is their responsibility to send it to their committees.
