Virtual Committee Chair Meeting - March 3rd, 2021

Treasurer's report: Beginning balance of \$16, 491.79, ending balance of \$16,041.79

Presidents report: Michelle thanked everyone for coming and started with the updates from her meeting with Mr. Webber. Michelle met with Mr. Webber regarding the mailers for seniors events, Tricky tray, etc and during the call he stated that going forward for this year, the After Prom will not be able to plan events with SHS's name attached. All events will be planned thru the township/district. At this time, we are not aware of what these events will be beyond the 'Prom in the park' and graduation. The Steering committee has decided to move forward with the Fundraisers that we already have in the works, but not pursue any new ones. **ALL** money raised this year will go towards getting something for the kids.
